Safety policy

A comprehensive safety briefing is given at the start of each trip before the boat moves away from the quay.

The crew are highly experienced mariners. All crew members are trained in first aid. Man overboard and recovery drills are regularly undertaken.

We have state of the art GPS navigation equipment and Radar and we are in touch at all times with the shore by VHF radio. The boat meets MCA and local authority regulations.

Lifejackets are provided for everyone on board and are worn at all times. The vessel is fitted with a liferaft with sufficient capacity for everyone on board. There is a comprehensive first aid kit, and a full set of firefighting equipment.

Passengers are asked to remain seated whilst the vessel is in motion so that there is no risk of falling overboard. Handholds are provided for everyone.
